D'VAR TORAH by Rabbi Dovid Goldwasser

ויקת ויתן את העדת אל הארן (שמות מ:כ).

He took and placed the Testimony into the Ark (Shemos 40:20).

This parashah sums up the long narrative about the building of the Mishkan. In reference to the two Tablets of the Ten Commandments, the Torah says that Moshe "took" them and then placed them in the Ark.

Rabbi Moshe Midner notes that it is only here that we are told that Moshe "took." In regard to Moshe's other actions in constructing the Mishkan, the verse speaks only of the final action: Moshe placed the various holy vessels in their respective places. Only about the Tablets does it say that he *took* them, and then *placed* them. We can learn from here that when it comes to Torah, a person must give as well as take. One should not be satisfied with learning for himself alone; he should strive to share his Torah knowledge with others.

Someone once consulted with the Chazon Ish about his wish to leave his position as a teacher of yeshivah children and take up another occupation. The sage asked him, "What do you wish to do?"

The man answered, "I'd like to learn to be a diamond polisher."

The Chazon Ish exclaimed, "But you already are!"
