An important message from OU Advocacy: With a budget deficit of more than \$1 billion, every line item in Pennsylvania's budget is at risk of being cut, including the Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs. These two programs are significant funding sources for Pennsylvania Jew-ish day schools and our day schools depend on this money. Without these programs, many fewer children would receive scholarships and tuitions would likely rise, requiring the entire community to support the schools even more than they already do.

In order to protect the EITC and OSTC programs and keep them in the state budget at their current funding levels, OU Advocacy-PA is organizing a mission to the statehouse on Wednesday, June 11. Now is the time for our legislators to hear how their constituents—parents and students—will be impacted if these programs are cut. The more people we bring to Harrisburg on June 11, the more our presence will be felt.
