The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs give Pennsylvania taxpayers the opportunity to direct their PA tax dollars to provide need-based scholarships for children at our region's 10 Jewish day schools and 25+ Jewish preschools. Through the efforts of the Jewish Scholarship, LLC, and the Foundation for Jewish Day Schools, over \$6.5 million in critical funds were awarded to children at our day schools, and nearly \$800,000 in scholarships were awarded to over 800 children in local Jewish preschools.
